URGENT NOTICE REGARDING LODGE DUES
DURING THE GOVERNMENT SHUTDOWN**

To: Fraternal Order of Police, Arizona Federal Lodge Members

Brothers and Sisters,

Arizona Federal Lodge stands with our members and understands the impact of the Government Shutdown. Effective January 28th, the billing cycle for February dues, Lodge members will not be charged their monthly dues. Instead, dues will be deferred until at least April or until members have been paid. This will only go into effect, if the shutdown has not been resolved and members have not been paid. Should the shutdown be resolved before January 28th, dues will be collected as scheduled.

So, what does this mean? Here is how the deferment will work:

AZ Federal Lodge Member A, had his January 28th dues (February dues) deferred for one month. In February, the shutdown is over. Member A's next billing cycle is set for on or about February 28 (March dues). Because Member A had his February dues deferred, Member A will have his February (\$40.00) and March (\$40.00) dues withdrawn from his account. Member A will have \$80.00 taken from his account, instead of the normal payment of \$40.00.
